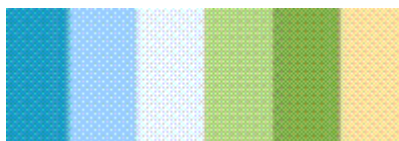

### **Participate in the State's Purchasing Agreement System**

With the passage of HB 09-1088, nonprofits that receive federal, state, or local government funds, including SCFD funding, are now eligible to participate in the state's purchasing agreement system with a large list of vendors. Eligible nonprofits must first fill out a cooperative purchasing agreement with the Department of Personnel and Administration and participate in a training by teleconference. In the event you cannot participate in one of the scheduled teleconference calls (see below), a short guide to using the procurement system will be posted by August 7th on the Department of Personnel and Administration website: <http://www.colorado.gov/dpa/dfp/spo/index.htm>
