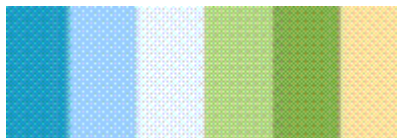

**Mudra Dance Studio**



The Founder and President Namita Khanna Nariani started [Mudra Dance Studio](#) (MDS) in 1993 with only 3 students. Over the years MDS has had increase in the number of students, number of teachers, number of classes for different age groups from the age

of 3 years to the age of 60 years, increase in number of classes, and also locations of these classes. MDS primarily teaches the classical dance form of "Kathak" which is derived from the word "Katha"; meaning story telling. Kathak is one of the 7 well-known classical dance forms of India, which trace back to 6000 BC and over the years have metamorphosed by cultural and geographical influences.

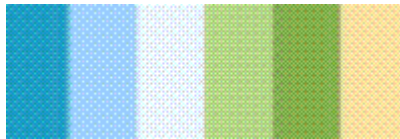

### Eligibility

[Eligibility Applications](#) are accepted between June 1 and October 31.

Staff is willing to meet with organizations regarding eligibility year round.

June 2009 Consumer Price Index and the projected [Tier II](#) 2010 qualifying threshold, the board determined these would likely not pose a significant impact on the stability of Tier II in 2010. Tier III county cultural councils were deemed likely to be unaffected as well.

SCFD Treasurer Jim Martin reported that the January through July 2009 sales and use tax revenue was down 15.12% over the same period in 2008. 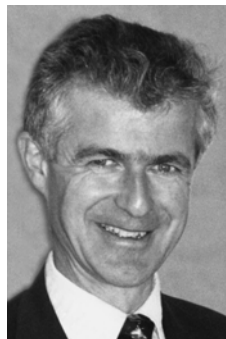
