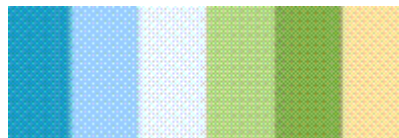

Board of Directors Meeting

The May 28, 2009 SCFD Board meeting was hosted by The Denver Art Museum. The meeting included presentation of the annual certification reports to the board by the Presidents of the Tier I organizations and a presentation from the Tier III community. The board also adopted Resolution 09-06 Pertaining to 2009 Tier I Funding.



Bob Grant was sworn in at the board meeting and began his three-year term as the Adams County appointee to the eleven-member board. Mr. Grant was a prosecutor in the 17th Judicial District for 28 years, the last 12 as its District Attorney until he was term-limited.

Mr. Grant has been active in his community for many years and currently serves on the Board of Directors of CASA of Adams and Broomfield Counties. He organized the Visual Arts Committee in 1998, when Adams County was building a new courthouse, to insure that public art would be included in the project. The successor Adams County Visual Arts Commission has since been incorporated into Adams County Government and has obtained commitments for over \$400,000 for public arts projects.

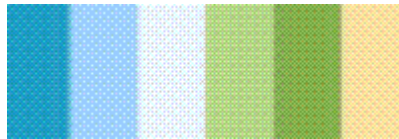
