VISIT DENVER selected SCFD to receive one of its [2009 Tourism Star Awards](#). It was presented at the Tourism Hall of Fame Dinner on Thursday, March 4th.

"In 2009, the Scientific & Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) celebrated 20 years of helping to reshape the landscape of Colorado into a world-class cultural center. The SCFD is an unique, seven-county collaboration that through a .1 percent sales and use tax raises approximately \$40 million annually that is distributed to more than 300 cultural organizations. In addition to improving the quality of life, Denver's art and cultural community generates more than \$1.7 billion in economic activity annually, much of this as result of SCFD funding."

SCFD Treasurer Joseph Arcese reported that the January 2010 SCFD sales and use tax revenue was \$2,791,471.19. This compares to January 2009 tax revenue of \$2,730,508.89. The variance is \$60,062.30. This is a 2.23% increase in over month-to-date (MTD) and year-to-date (YTD) 2009 and is the third consecutive month of reported MTD increases since August 2008.

Executive Director Peg Long announced the dates for the 2010 revenue distributions: June 8th (Tier I), September 10th (Tiers I & II), October (Tier III, at check ceremonies), December 10th (Tiers I & II) and March 2011 (Tiers I and II). A total of \$37,032,160 is projected to be distributed.

The next regular SCFD Board meeting is scheduled for 1pm Thursday, April 22, 2010 at the [Broomfield Cultural Affairs Division](#), in the Mamie Doud Library, located at 3 Community Park Rd, Broomfield, CO 80020.

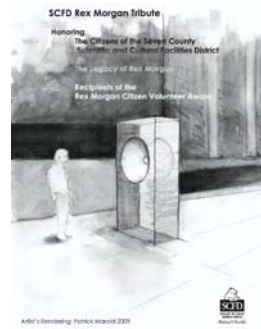
